

Statistics

Not only Kazakhs are coming to the republic (they constitute 50-55% of the inflow), but also Russians-24-27%, and Ukrainians, Tatars, and Uzbeks—2-3% each. Between 1998 and 2017, 89,400 families, or 407,600 oralmans, resettled in Kazakhstan, mainly in the Almaty (38,700), Zham-byl (25,500), Mangistau (47,700), and South Kazakhstan regions (96,100 people).
