STEP 1 - 5 min

Department 1

- Choose the route that allows tourists to visit other cities during trip.

(Milan, Verona, Venice, San Marino, Florence, Rome, Pompei)

or

(Rome, Pompei, Florence, San Marino, Venice, Verona, Milan)

* Underlined cities recommended for overnight (stay in the hotel)

* You can choose your own rout, arrival and departure cities.

Department 2, 3 & 4

- Plan the number of days to stay in each city
- Total number of trip 14 days 13 nights

Department 5

- Start researching the cost of Airport transfer to city center in Milan and Rome
- Look for possible ways of traveling by bus or train or plane between cities.

* Department 5 works with all other Departments 1,2,3,4 in collaboration

STEP 2 - 25 min

After the arrival and departure cities set The touristic rout and number of days in each city set

Department 1 & 5 - Planning **welcome meeting** in Airport, choose the hotel in city center, planning **transfer** to city center, after finishing the city tour (a few hours or several days) to plan transfer to next city

- Use web pages as <u>www.booking.com</u> or <u>www.expedia.com</u>,
- Also look for low cost flights between cities, bus or train connections.

Department 2 - Places to visit (attractions, museums, sightseeing)

- Please provide short descriptions
- Why we have to visit that place
- Photo or short video,
- Location on city map (Collaborate with Department 1).

Department 3 - Schools, Colleges & Universities

- Please present most popular educational institution in the city
- Why they are popular
- Which famous person graduate from university or school
- Short descriptions, photo or short video
- Location on city map (Collaborate with Department 1).

Department 4 - Cafe, Restaurants, sport, adventure parks, Zoo, & Botanical gardens

- What you recommend to taste in this city? (Pizza, pasta ...)
- Choose the cafe or restaurant **near the attraction or museum** guests will be visiting (Collaborate with **Department 3**).
- Suggests places to visit as sport events or adventure parks, zoo or botanical garden (not necessary each city)

Department 5 - Financial Department

Works in collaboration with **Departments 1, 2, 3 and 4** to research in Internet and calculate:

- Airport transfers (Airport to city center)
- Hotel cost per night (BB including bed and breakfast)
- Entrance tickets cost for museums and attractions
- Lunch and dinner cost in café and restaurant per person
- Transfers between cities (train, airline, bus)

STEP 3 - 25 min

All Departments presenting their findings (5 min each department)
